#### **Management and Staff**

The management always provides timely support and guidance for the smooth functioning of the School. With the immense support and the timely intervention of the management helps our school to move forward to the heights. The management has given top priority to appoint well qualified and talented teaches in our school. Rev. Sr. Rosin, the manager and Rev. Sr. Subha, the education Councillor, Sr. Laisa MA, the Principal, Mr. Manoj Joseph, the Vice Principal along with 31 talented and experienced teachers, and with nine non-teaching staff worked together to fulfill the needs of this new generation.

### **New Academic Year & Staff Enrichment program**

The management organized different training program for teachers as part of the preparation of the new school year. Ratnasagar Publishing Company provided resource persons for the training programs. On April 17<sup>th</sup> 2024 our Teachers had NEP and NCF training as part of the implementation of National Education Policy in all the schools. On May 27<sup>th</sup>, 2024 they also provided Hand Writing workshop for our teachers, from which the teachers learned the importance of good handwriting skill. On July 13, 2024, 19 teachers from our school attended the Teachers seminar was held at Christhu Jyothi public School Rajakkad.

Every academic year training, seminars and orientation programs are conducted for teachers to improve and implement innovative ideas in teaching learning practices as well as to take the students beyond their current level of learning. This year too teachers participated in all the mandatory workshops by CBSE as well as from other publication houses in and online mode.

We also added IT as the skill subject in Class X this year and the students could use the computer lab facilities for their practical exam. The school is also hired a full time lab technician to assist the students at any time. “e-School” software is installed for the smooth daily functioning of the school.

### **UKG GRADUATION DAY**

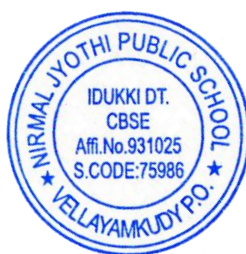
